Good day!

My wife has been suffering from a heart failure known as bradycardia since December, 2012 wherein the number of heart beats per minute is lower than the normal of 60 beats per minute. She was advised for permanent pacemaker insertion in April, 2014 and, again, in May, 2015 but was not able to undergo the procedure due to financial constraints. Just last June 12-19, 2017, she was admitted at the Silliman University Medical Center for the same illness. After some tests, her doctor found out that her heart condition had worsened even pumping only **an alarming of 19-20 heart beats per minute - a condition which is much lower than the normal of 60.** Because of this, her doctor advised for immediate pacemaker insertion after being discharged.

Since then, I approached government agencies and government leaders in our community to request for financial assistance.

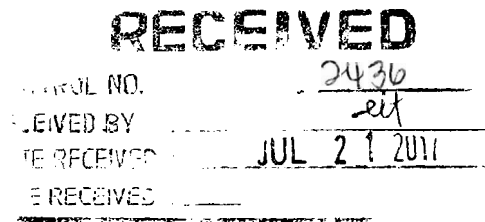
My problem now is the doctor's professional fee as, according to reliable sources, this can not be paid by guarantee letters.

In view of this, I humbly request our Dumaguete City DepEd family for financial assistance. Any amount extended will be greatly appreciated and will forever be cherished in our hearts with deep gratitude.


This is a 65 year-old female, married from Dumaguete City who was recently admitted last June 12 to 17, 2017 for cardiac arrhythmia and acute sinusitis. Patient has been hypertensive for more than 5 years and diabetic for more than 4 years. She has been diagnosed to have hypothyroidism and sick sinus syndrome since December, 2012 manifested as syncope and severe bradyarrhythmia with long pauses. She was advised for permanent pacemaker insertion but due to financial constraint was unable to comply. At present, she has episodes of dizziness, chest pain and exertional dyspnea.

Her present medications include telmisartan+amlodipine 40/5 mg daily, trimetazidine 35 mg twice daily, isosorbide mononitrate 30 mg daily, clopidogrel 75 mg daily, thyroxine 50 mcg daily, paracetamol+tramadol prn for pain and isosorbide dinitrate sublingual tab prn for chest pain.

Medical diagnoses: Sick Sinus Syndrome; Ischemic Heart Disease; Hypertension; Diabetes mellitus; Dyslipidemia; Hypothyroidism; and Osteoarthritis.

She is advised for further cardiovascular management and permanent pacemaker insertion at higher centers like the Philippine Heart Center.
