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

ON THE SPOT POSTER MAKING CONTEST RULES AND GUIDELINES

Qualifications.

1. Open to all bona fide High School (Grades 7-10) enrolled in Public and Private schools.
2. Only one (1) contestant must be sent by each participating school.
3. All previous winners and children of PDA members are not allowed to join the competition.

Requirements.

1. Each contestant must submit an accomplished Official Entry Form (properly filled out with 2x2 picture of the participant with signature). The form must be placed in a **LONG BROWN ENEVELOPE** addressed to:

The name of the school and its official contact number must be printed on the upper right corner of the envelope (in CAPSLOCK).

2. The official entry form must be submitted on or before January 19, 2017.
3. NO entries will be entertained after the deadline. Contestants who submitted after the deadline are automatically disqualified.

General Contest Rules and Guidelines.

1. All contestants must be at the venue (Lamberto Macias) at 7:00 in the morning. Contestants who will come late will be accepted, however, a 10 point deduction shall be imposed from the overall score.
2. A drawing of lots will be done to determine contestant's number.
3. Materials to be used during the contest must be submitted to the Organizing team. The following are the drawing materials that are allowed to be used:
 - a. Pencils, erasers, craypass, markers (black or blue), cotton or tissue; and
 - b. One (1) piece 20"x30" (standard ½ size) Master Illustration Board per contestant shall be provided by the Organizing team.

No other materials will be used. Those materials listed above are only allowed during the competition. Non-compliance to this rule shall mean a 10-point deduction from the overall score.
4. The artwork must be in LANDSCAPE layout orientation. A 10-point deduction from the overall score will be imposed for those who do not follow the prescribed layout.
5. All contestants shall be given 2 hours (7:30 am to 9:30 am) to finish their work.
6. Using of phones or any device for communication is not allowed.
7. Contestants who use poster guides or samples during the competition will be disqualified automatically. If an emergency call is needed, the contestant must inform the Organizing team.
8. No contestant shall be allowed to leave the contest premises once the competition has started.
9. A bell will ring to inform that the time is up and all entries must be submitted.
10. The following criteria shall be used to identify the winners for this year's On the Spot Poster Making Contest:

a. Originality, style and creativity	-40%
b. Interpretation and relevance to the theme	-40%
c. Presentation and neatness	-20%

CHANT FOR SMILES GENERAL GUIDELINES

Qualifications.

1. The competition is open to all Public and Private High Schools in Dumaguete City.
2. Each competing team shall be composed of a minimum of 12 and a maximum of 20 members.
3. The participating team shall compose their own Chant. It must be original. The piece may be written in English, Filipino, or Cebuano.

3. Each team may bring and use their own instruments (percussion, drums or the like, non-electrical) for sound effects purposes.
4. The team may use props. The use of flammable liquid is **NOT ALLOWED**.
5. Winners shall be determined using the following criteria:

Choreography and Execution	-30%
Mastery	-20%
Overall Performance	-20%
Originality and Creativity	-20%
Audience Impact	-10%
6. Top 3 best groups will be selected and awarded with the following prizes:

Grand Prize Winner	- PhP 5,000.00 and trophy
1 st runner-up	-PhP 3,000.00 and trophy
2 nd runner-up	-PhP 2,000.00 and trophy
7. Non-winners will be given a Certificate and a token.
8. The decision of the judges is FINAL and IRREVOCABLE.
