SUBJECT : **SURVEY ON THE REVISION OF SCHOOL REDISTRICTING
POLICY**

DATE : January 26, 2023

This refers to DepEd Memorandum No. 057, s. 2021, or the **Moratorium on the Request for School Redistricting and Schools Division Reclassification**, which provided guidance to the field offices as regards to the piece meal request on the creation of new districts within a Schools Division Office. Specifically, said memorandum states that:

*All redistricting requests endorsed to DepEd CO, including those that are pending for tagging in the Learner Information System (LIS) and Basic Education Information System (EBEIS) from Regions and SDOs **shall be put on hold until an updated policy and guidelines related to school redistricting have been issued. Likewise, request for SDO size reclassification shall also be held in abeyance until the redistricting policy has been issued.***

Relatively, preliminary activities for the issuance of an updated policy were initiated such as creation of a technical working group who will review existing policies, data gathering on existing guidelines used by field offices in redistricting clusters of schools, and review and revision of job descriptions of related teaching positions at the RO &

SDOs. These preparatory activities are necessary to revise and update the school redistricting standards which was based on the 1997 DECS-DBM staffing standards.

In this regard, the Bureau of Human Resource and Organizational Development – Organization Effectiveness Division will be conducting an online **Survey on the Revision of School Redistricting Standards** that intends to gather evidence-based data from target respondents from the Central, Regions, Schools Division Offices and Schools/ Learning Centers.

Target respondents for the survey are School Heads, Teachers, and Non-Teaching Staff from Schools/Learning Centers. Personnel from the Central and Field Offices who interact with schools are also encouraged to answer the survey to provide feedback on technical assistance, school visits, and monitoring & evaluation activities carried out at the school level. All responses and information that will be gathered shall be treated with confidentiality in compliance with the Data Privacy Act of 2012. The personal information of all respondents will be analyzed to create a demographic profile that may be used to inform key decision-makers and stakeholders to help ensure that succeeding programs, projects, and activities are aligned with DepEd goals and objectives.
